Camp Leader - City Adventure Camp and Virtual Camping Programs

Role

Easter Seals BC/Yukon is seeking an Camp Leaders to provide supervision and support to participants in the Easter Seals City Adventure Camp (CAC) program and Virtual Camping (VCAMP) Program.

The CAC camp is an activity-based day program that aims to help people with disabilities, between the ages 13-29, develop new skills and confidence through activities in their local communities.

The VCAMP program aims to provide recreational programming for people with disabilities between the ages of 6-49 via Zoom during the Covid-19 Pandemic.

These programs are overseen by the Outreach Coordinator, who trains and supports the Camp team in providing both programs simultaneously over the months of July and August.

Responsibilities:

The role will provide support, supervision, and leadership to participants in the City Adventure Day Camp and Virtual Camp Programs. Duties include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Participate in and plan all program activities
- Familiarize self with activity locations and transit routes
- Provide camp programming for Virtual Participants
- Attend to the participants' wellbeing, ensuring they feel secure, comfortable, and welcome
- As much as possible, encourage each participant's independence and recognize and utilize potentials for personal growth or social development.
- Provide supervision and ensure that effective standards of safety are always maintained
- Debrief with the group after their experiences that day
- Remain upbeat and always serve as a positive role model
- Complete participant evaluations and all necessary paperwork

Qualifications:

- Valid Standard First Aid with CPR-C
- Clean Criminal Record Check within the past 6 months
- Ability to troubleshoot and think quickly in times of crisis to ensure a positive result
- Ability to work effectively with other team members as well as function independently
- Ability to adapt and adjust in a changing environment
- Ability to cope in a demanding environment
- Experience in youth and community programming with an understanding of diverse abilities
- Strong communication and personal skills
- Extremely well organized with strong multi-tasking abilities



Term:

As these programs occur virtually in addition to running in Vancouver, Victoria, Surrey, and Kelowna, staff will be selected as to fulfill the needs of the program geographically. Should you be able to participate in only the Virtual Camping Program due to living outside of these areas, please indicate "Virtual Camp ONLY" on your application, as there are limited available positions for those outside of the areas required.

Staff will be supporting multiple programs on a rotating basis. For example, in Week 1 a staff member may run Virtual Camp, and in Week 2 they may support the Vancouver CAC program. Alternatively, a staff living in Victoria may work weeks 1-4 of the Victoria CAC program, and work the remainder of August on the Virtual Camp.

Staff Training – June 22nd – July 1st (flexible, may change).

Virtual Camp – July 4th – August 12th (6 weeks)

Vancouver CAC – July 4th – August 12th (6 weeks)

Victoria CAC- July 4th – July 29th (4 weeks)

Kelowna CAC – August 1st – 26th (4 weeks)

Surrey CAC – August 15th – 26th (2 weeks)
