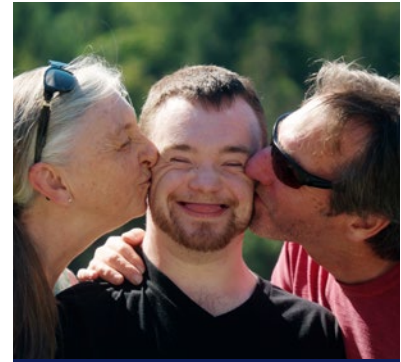


## YOUR IMPACT

In the fall of 2015 Chef Hawksworth began a culinary partnership with Air Canada to design a selection of innovative, sophisticated, and Canadian-influenced seasonal signature dishes, featured exclusively on Air Canada flights in International Business Class and Signature Lounges. In 2019, Air Canada was recognized by Skytrax for offering the "World's Best Business Class Lounge Dining."

Hawksworth also owns and operates popular concepts Nightingale named "Canada's Best Farm to Table Restaurant" and Bel Café. All demonstrate Hawksworth's culinary expertise, talent for creative flavour combinations, his drive for perfection, and insistence on only the best ingredients.
